

Next Generation Nepal Statistics

-February 2007 through October 2020



NGN has accomplished the following between February 2007 and October 2020:

- **499** missions have been organized in **36** districts of Nepal. These included family tracing, reconnections, reintegration, reunifications and monitoring.
- Found the families of **688** displaced children and reconnected them through facilitated communication and trip.
- **322** trafficked and displaced children have been rescued and permanently reunified with their families.
- **61** civil society organizations, government bodies or individuals have been trained and/or technically advised in our methodology and approach
- **34** youth have been supported through some or all of the following: support towards educational fees and material support at SLC, +2, diplomas or bachelor level; as well as one-to-one mentoring, shelter, food, medical costs and leisure costs.
- At least **6** diplomatic missions in Nepal have changed their travel advice to warn against orphanage voluntourism as a result of NGN advocacy.
- **61** talks and events have been delivered to spread awareness of the dangers of orphanage voluntourism and our advocacy work has been covered in **103** media reports.

- **11** child friendly spaces supporting **1418** children have been established following the 2015 earthquake to protect the children against trafficking.
- **74816** vehicles have been stopped and searched in earthquake affected areas, out of which **132** 'at risk' children have been intercepted and protected.
- **48,425** people have been reached in trafficking prone communities of Humla, Mugu, and Sindhupalchowk districts through **137** street drama shows to warn them about the dangers of trafficking and the importance of family preservation.
- **8512** people including local leader, chairman of municipal office, ward offices, government official members of local club and mothers' group have been orientated on child rights and sensitized on danger of trafficking through 154 advocacy meetings.
- Over **90,000** people have been reached in earthquake affected areas to warn them about the dangers of trafficking and the importance of family preservation.
- Over **300** people from **56** families have been supported with food supplies and hygiene kit including mask and sanitizers to fight Covid-19 crisis.
