## **Rescue and Reintegration Success!**

Since our last Snapshots, we have been busy rescuing and returning children! Even during the Covid lockdowns, our team in Nepal did amazing work. The Government of Nepal and NGN rescued 14 children from two different orphanages who are now residing in NGN's transit home. They were being kept under terrible conditions and had various health conditions that NGN treated. They thrived in our transit home and were able to resume their educations and get healthy. Now we are in the process of getting them all home! Occasionally we rescue children whose parents are deceased or unable to care for them. When the extended family is also not an option, we explore long-term care options with highly vetted child care facilities such as SOS (Socially Responsible Society).

\*All recently reintegrated families also received essential goods under our Covid response project.
