1. Tallo Nagma

First event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 1, Tallo Nagma on 1st April. There were approx. 285 participants in the event which included 85 male, 88 female and 112 children. Ward chairperson also participated in the event.

2. Chauda Bhigma

Second Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 1, Chauda Bhigma on 1st April. There were approx 244 participants in the event which included 56 male, 87 female and 101 children.

3. Rakal Bada

Third Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 3, Rakal Bada on April 2. Approx. 301 people participated in the event which included 78 male, 67 female and 156 children. Acting chairperson of the ward attended the event.

4. Badam Bada

Fourth event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 3, Badam Bada on April 2. Approx. 345 people participated the event which included 103 male, 121 female and 121 children. Acting chairperson of the ward attended the event.

5. Dharali

Fifth Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 3, Dharali on April 3. Approx 201 people attended the event which included 52 male, 64 female and 85 children.

6. Ratada

Sixth Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 2 Ratada on April 3. There were approximately 315 participants attending the event which included 84 male, 114 female and 118 children. The ward chairperson also attended the event.

7. Rachuli

Seventh Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 4 on April 4. There were 503 participants who attended the event. Among them, 156 were male, 79 were female and 265 were children. The event took place in Kalika Secondary School of Tilagufa. The event was also attended by the ward chairperson and the principal of and other staff of the school.

8. Khalla

Eighth Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 5, Khalla on April 4. There were approximately 312 participants among them, 75 were male, 98 were female and 139 were children. The event was also participated by the ward chairperson and the school teachers of the local school.

9. Galje

Ninth Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 6, Galje on April 5. 427 people participated in the event. Among which there were 115 male, 92 female and 220 children. The staff of Tilagufa Municipality, and chairperson and teachers of the local school also attended the event.

10. Rudhu

Tenth Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 10, Rudhu on April 6. 357 people participated in the event among which there were 112 male, 95 female and 150 children. Ward representatives and school principal of the local schools also attended the event.

11. Chilkhaya

Eleventh Event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 9, Chilkhaya on 7th April. There were 405 participants attending the event among which there were 117 male, 113 female and 175 children. Member of Tilagufa Municipality, ward Chairperson, police personnel, and school teachers of the village also attended the event.

12. Dhimniya

Twelfth event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 11, Dhimniya on 7th April. 375 people participated in the event among them, 95 were male, 118 were female and 162 were children. Ward chairperson of the ward also attended the event.

13. Naibada

The team performed thirteenth event in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 7, Naibada village on 8th April. 609 people including 195 male, 117 female and 297 children attended the event. Ward chairperson, chairperson of children network, school principal, and children journalist also attended the event.

14. Okhadbhitta

Fourteenth event took place in Tilagufa Municipality ward no. 8, Okhadbhitta village on 9th April. 321 people attended the event among which 75 were male, 95 were female and 151 were children.

15. Gela

Fifteenth event took place in Mahabai Rural Municipality ward no. 5, Gela on 9th April. There were 418 participants who took part as audience in the event. Among the participants there were 125 male, 130 female and 163 children. The ward chairperson and ward secretariat also participated in the event.

16. Kuni Ganeshkot

Sixteenth event took place in Mahabai Rural Municipality ward no. 6, Kuni Ganeshkot on 10th April. There were 462 people attending the event. Among them 154 were male, 133 were female and 175 were children.

17. Ramnikot

Seventeenth event took place in Mahabai Rural Municipality ward no. 7 Ramnikot on 10th April. There were 308 people attending the event. Among them, 78 were male, 109 were female and 121 were children. Ward members, school teachers and principal of the local school also attended the event.

18. Dillikot

Eighteenth and the final event took place in Mahabai Rural Municipality ward no. 3 Dillikot on 11th April. There drama show was attended by 416 people. Among the total attendees, 112 were male, 102 were female and 202 were children. Ward chairperson, school principals and the school teachers also attended the event.

Feedback from Participants:

The drama show conducted in all the 18 villages had good number of audiences. The audiences had overwhelmingly positive response towards the drama show. Most of them shared that it is very relevant. The audiences appreciated our effort to aware people against trafficking of children into institution. Ward chairperson of various wards also attended and gave feedback to our drama. They have mentioned that they will check on the suspicious activities in the future and help prevent trafficking from their ward. Overall the audiences were satisfied and understood the message we wanted to give from the drama show.

Conclusion:

18 street drama were planned for the fiscal year 2021-22. All the shows were successfully completed as planned. The dramas were performed in Tilagufa Municipality and Mahabai Rural Municipality of Kalikot district. We were able to reach 6604 people from the 18 drama show. Chairperson of the ward, ward secretary, members from the municipality office, school principal, teachers and members of child club were in the audience who saw our drama. The audiences gave very positive feedback and understood the message we wanted to give via drama.
